We will be camping at sites in the FISH (112-129), DEER (130-144), and OWL (92-111) loops of the OH RIDGE campground. Campsites in the OWL loop are NOT reservable, and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis at the campground. Campsites in the FISH and DEER loops are available by reservation. Log-on to recreation.gov, and enter "OH RIDGE" into the "Park or Facility name" box, and click the "Search Facilities" button to find available campsites. If FISH and DEER loops are full, please feel free to reserve ANY other available campsite; ALL sites are within walking distance of the meeting area in FISH loop.

TRAILERS can be rented and spotted on your campsite by Adventure in Camping at adventureincamping.com or 760.935.4890, OR by Tioga Vacation Trailer Rentals at tiogavacationtrailerrentals.com or 760.647.6020.
