

A.A. Membership Survey?!

Did you know that A.A. conducts a membership survey? Why would A.A. do that? Is that a good thing or a bad thing? What about anonymity?

The survey is anonymous. It asks questions about how you found A.A. What influenced you to attend your first meeting. How long you have been sober. If you have a home group. What your ethnicity is. What your profession is. If you have a sponsor. It takes less than 5-minutes to complete.

A.A. USES THIS SURVEY TO

- tell A.A. members about their Fellowship;
- observe patterns in the A.A. membership;
- provide information about A.A. to the professional community;
- inform the public about what A.A. does.

Step 11

Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God as we understood Him, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.

Tradition 11(short form)

Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio, and films.

Concept 11(short form)

The trustees should always have the best possible committees, corporate service directors, executives, staffs, and consultants. Composition, qualifications, induction procedures, and rights and duties will always be matters of serious concern.
